

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Protecting your privacy and the security of your personal data are of great importance to the Turing Foundation. As such, the Turing Foundation handles personal data with the utmost care and secures it in accordance with the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act (Wbp) and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Processing of personal data

The Turing Foundation collects and processes personal data for the following purposes:

- entering into and executing agreements with subsidising bodies;
- sending invitations for award ceremonies and events;
- processing employment applications;
- our business operations

The Turing Foundation only collects (personal) data from you, not from third parties. We treat this personal data confidentially. The data is kept and stored on a secure database by third parties. These third parties may only process your personal data for the services agreed with the Turing Foundation. The data is not passed on to other parties.

Which personal data does the Turing Foundation collect?

The Turing Foundation processes the following personal data:

- name and address details (name, address, place of residence);
- bank account number (IBAN);
- telephone number (mobile and/or fixed line);
- sex;
- e-mail address

Data retention

In accordance with the Wbp and the GDPR, the Turing Foundation does not store your personal data any longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data was collected.

Use of cookies

The Turing Foundation does not use cookies on its website.
